P. 2002, 3017(a), and 9010, FDIC-R requests that notices given or required to be given in these cases, including but not limited to orders, reports, pleadings, motions, applications, petitions, requests, complaints, or demands, whether formal or informal, whether transmitted or conveyed by mail, delivery, telephone, telecopy, telex, or otherwise, be given and served upon the undersigned counsel at the respective addresses set forth below.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that neither this request nor any subsequent appearance, pleading, claim, proof of service, document, suit, motion nor any other writing or conduct, shall constitute a waiver of the within party's:

- a. Sovereign immunity;
- b. Right to have any and all final orders in any and all non-core matters entered only after *de novo* review by a United States District Court Judge;

- c. Right to trial by jury in any proceeding as to any and all matters so triable herein, whether or not the same be designated legal or private rights, or in any case, controversy of proceeding related thereto, notwithstanding the designation *vel non* of such matters as "core proceedings" pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(H), and whether such jury trial right is pursuant to statute or United States Constitution;
- d. Right to have the reference withdrawn by the United States District Court in any matter or proceeding subject to mandatory or discretionary withdrawal; and
- e. Other rights, claims, actions, defenses, setoffs, recoupment or other matters to which this party is entitled under any agreement or at law or in equity or under the United States Constitution.

All of the foregoing rights are expressly reserved and preserved without exception and with no purpose of conceding jurisdiction in any way by filing this Notice of Appearance. FDIC-R expressly reserves all rights at law and equity to assert the preemption of the Court's jurisdiction and the exclusive jurisdiction provided under Title 12 as applicable with respect to the FDIC-R.


