
Honorable Court:

I would just like to state that my claim is 602.6572 shares of Advanta Corp Class B stock that I acquired while employed at Advanta Leasing through the Employee Stock Option Plan. I kept the shares with Morgan Stanley even after I was laid off due to the closing of Advanta's leasing division in 2001. The cost to me of these shares amounted to \$4,331.04.

I don't know the bankruptcy law to determine whether my claim is a claim versus an interest. However, any entitlement to restitution would be appreciated. I can not hire an attorney as that would only add to the financial burden. Thank you for your consideration.
