**ORDER CONFIRMING PARTIES' SELECTION OF MEDIATOR

AND NOW, this 30th day of July, 2010, various parties involved in disputes concerning the Debtors' tax elections with regard to its amended 2008 federal and it's 2009 consolidated federal income tax returns (Adv. D.I. 9), together with disputes involving the FDIC-R's automatic stay motion (Adv. D.I. 25) (collectively, the "Disputes"), such Disputes scheduled for hearing on August 17-18, 2010, having advised the Court on July 23, 2010 of their desire to engage in mediation in an attempt to resolve the Disputes,


AND, the parties having advised the court on July 23, 2010 that they have asked, and that the Honorable Robert D. Drain has agreed, to mediate the Disputes prior to the above-noted scheduled hearing dates.

1. As requested by various parties, the Disputes of the Debtors are referred to Judge Drain for mediation, to take place at such time and place, and to be conducted in such manner, as designated by Judge Drain, after consultation with the parties; and

2. The person or persons having the necessary authority to settle the matter(s) shall appear at the mediation, unless excused by Judge Drain.
